I am concerned that the proposed across the board 5% tuition increase will be very harmful to our BSN business.

- Based on a pricing "deep dive" we performed this summer, our normalized tuition per credit hour is \$353, UoP (our biggest competitor) is \$300, Walden is \$283, and Grand Canyon is \$277.
- The median price of our major competitors (excluding Kaplan) is \$283 per credit hour.
- Nursing does not have a 90/10 problem.

- It has been reported, that typically a 5% tuition increase results in a 12% fall in starts.
- On surveys of students who apply or inquire but don't enroll at KU BSN, price is one of the main issues currently.
- Even if we rebalance later in 2010 and reduce the tuition, I am concerned that 2 price changes in one year, will significantly hurt our business.
