A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the BOLD Infrastructure for Alzheimer’s Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Building Our Largest
5 Dementia Infrastructure for Alzheimer’s Reauthorization
6 Act of 2024” or the “BOLD Infrastructure for Alz-
7 heimer’s Reauthorization Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROGRAMS WITH RESPECT TO ALZ-**
2 **HEIMER'S DISEASE AND RELATED DEMEN-**
3 **TIAS.**

4 (a) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS TO STATES AND
5 PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENTS FOR ALZHEIMER'S DIS-
6 EASE AND RELATED DEMENTIAS.—Section 398 of the
7 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280c–3) is amend-
8 ed—

9 (1) in subsection (a)—

10 (A) in the matter preceding paragraph (1),
11 by striking “in coordination with the Director
12 of the Centers for Disease Control and Preven-
13 tion and” and inserting “acting through the Di-
14 rector of the Centers for Disease Control and
15 Prevention, and in coordination with”; and

16 (B) in paragraph (7), by adding a period
17 at the end; and

18 (2) by transferring subsection (f) to appear
19 after subsection (e).

20 (b) PROMOTION OF PUBLIC HEALTH KNOWLEDGE
21 AND AWARENESS OF ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND RE-
22 LATED DEMENTIAS.—Section 398A(a) of the Public
23 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280c–4(a)) is amended—

24 (1) in paragraph (1), in the matter preceding
25 subparagraph (A), by striking “in coordination with
26 the Director of the Centers for Disease Control and

1 Prevention and the heads of other agencies as” and
2 inserting “acting through the Director of the Cen-
3 ters for Disease Control and Prevention, and in co-
4 ordination with the heads of other agencies, as”; and

5 (2) in paragraph (2)(C)—

6 (A) in clause (vii), by striking “; and” and
7 inserting a semicolon;

8 (B) by redesignating clause (viii) as clause
9 (ix); and

10 (C) by inserting after clause (vii) the fol-
11 lowing:

12 “(viii) identifying and translating
13 findings from clinical trials and other stud-
14 ies on Alzheimer’s disease and related de-
15 mentias, including studies on risk reduc-
16 tion, for application and integration into
17 effective and sustained community-level
18 evidence-based practices, interventions, and
19 policies; and”.

20 (c) REAUTHORIZATION OF PROGRAMS.—Section
21 398B(e) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
22 280c–5(e)) is amended by inserting “, and \$33,000,000
23 for each of fiscal years 2025 through 2029” before the
24 period at the end.

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
