4 (a) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS TO STATES AND
5 PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENTS FOR ALZHEIMER'S DIS-
6 EASE AND RELATED DEMENTIAS.—Section 398 of the
7 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280e-3) is amend-
8 ed—

9 (1) in subsection (a)—

10 (A) in the matter preceding paragraph

11 (1)—

12 (i) by striking “in coordination with
13 the Director of the Centers for Disease
14 Control and Prevention and the heads of
15 other agencies” and inserting “acting
16 through the Director of the Centers for
17 Disease Control and Prevention, and in co-
18 ordination with the heads of other relevant
19 Federal departments and agencies”; and

20 (ii) by striking “tribes” and inserting
21 “Tribes”;

22 (B) in paragraph (7), by striking “or the
23 Director of the Centers for Disease Control and
24 Prevention, as appropriate” and inserting “, as
25 appropriate.”;

1 (2) in subsection (c)(1), by striking “or Direc-
2 tor of the Centers for Disease Control and Preven-
3 tion”;

4 (3) in subsection (e), by striking “Indian tribe”
5 each place it appears and inserting “Indian Tribe”;

6 (4) by transferring subsection (f) to appear
7 after subsection (e); and

8 (5) by striking “tribal” each place it appears
9 and inserting “Tribal”.

10 (b) PROMOTION OF PUBLIC HEALTH KNOWLEDGE
11 AND AWARENESS OF ALZHEIMER’S DISEASE AND RE-
12 LATED DEMENTIAS.—Section 398A of the Public Health
13 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280c-4) is amended—

14 (1) in subsection (a)—

15 (A) in paragraph (1), in the matter pre-
16 ceding subparagraph (A), by striking “in co-
17 ordination with the Director of the Centers for
18 Disease Control and Prevention and the heads
19 of other agencies as” and inserting “acting
20 through the Director of the Centers for Disease
21 Control and Prevention, and in coordination
22 with the heads of other relevant Federal depart-
23 ments and agencies, as”; and

24 (B) in paragraph (2)(C)—

1 (i) in clause (vii), by striking “; and”
2 and inserting a semicolon;

3 (ii) in clause (viii), by striking “or the
4 Director of the Centers for Disease Control
5 and Prevention”;

6 (iii) by redesignating clause (viii) as
7 clause (ix); and

8 (iv) by inserting after clause (vii) the
9 following:

10 “(viii) identifying and translating
11 findings from clinical trials and other stud-
12 ies on Alzheimer’s disease and related de-
13 mentias, including studies related to reduc-
14 ing risk of cognitive decline or impairment,
15 into evidence-based practices and interven-
16 tions; and”;

17 (2) by striking “tribal” each place it appears
18 and inserting “Tribal”; and

19 (3) by striking “Indian tribes” each place it ap-
20 pears and inserting “Indian Tribes”.

21 (c) REAUTHORIZATION OF PROGRAMS.—Section
22 398B of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280c-
23 5) is amended—

24 (1) in subsection (d)—

1 (A) by striking “tribe” and inserting
2 “Tribe”; and

3 (B) by striking “tribal” and inserting
4 “Tribal”; and

5 (2) in subsection (e), by inserting “, and
6 \$33,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2025 through
7 2029” before the period at the end.
