5 (a) **COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER PROGRAM.**—In
6 addition to amounts otherwise available, there is appro-
7 priated to the Secretary of Health and Human Services
8 for fiscal year 2022, out of any money in the Treasury
9 not otherwise appropriated, \$6,000,000,000, to remain
10 available until expended, to provide enhanced funding for
11 the community health center program under section 330

1 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 254b). Of
2 such amount so appropriated—

3 (1) \$4,000,000,000 shall be made available for
4 general operations; and

5 (2) \$2,000,000,000 shall be made available for
6 capital projects.

7 (b) NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE CORPS.—In addi-
8 tion to amounts otherwise available, there is appropriated
9 to the Secretary of Health and Human Services for fiscal
10 year 2022, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise
11 appropriated, \$3,000,000,000, to remain available until
12 expended, to provide enhanced funding for the National
13 Health Service Corps.

14 (c) NURSE CORPS.—In addition to amounts other-
15 wise available, there is appropriated to the Secretary of
16 Health and Human Services for fiscal year 2022, out of
17 any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
18 \$500,000,000, to remain available until expended, for car-
19 rying out section 846 of the Public Health Service Act
20 (42 U.S.C. 297n).
