7 U.S.C. 1395 et seq.).

8 (B) Changes that are expected, in accord-
9 ance with such plan, to spending under the
10 Medicaid program under title XIX of the Social
11 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.).

12 (C) Changes that are expected, in accord-
13 ance with such plan, to spending under the sup-
14 plemental nutrition assistance program under
15 the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C.
16 2011 et seq.).

17 (D) The capacity for primary care pro-
18 viders to offer nutrition intervention services.

19 (E) The impact of inflation on food secu-
20 rity.

21 (F) The impact on health plan premiums
22 associated with reimbursement for nutrition-re-
23 lated services.
