3 **LIMITS.**

4 If there is a breach of the discretionary spending lim-
5 its (as such terms are defined in section 250(e) of the Bal-
6 anced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985
7 (2 U.S.C. 900(e)) for a fiscal year, and amounts are made
8 available from the Account to Address the Primary Care
9 Physician Shortage under section 747(e)(6) of the Public
10 Health Service Act (as added by section 204), the Account
11 to Address the Nursing Workforce Shortage under section
12 831(e)(5) of the Public Health Service Act (as added by

1 section 205), or the Account to Address the Nurse Faculty
2 Shortage under section 846A(c)(2) of the Public Health
3 Service Act (as added by section 206) for such fiscal year,
4 notwithstanding such Act—

5 (1) there shall be a sequestration only of
6 amounts made available from such Accounts in the
7 amount equal to the lesser of—

8 (A) the amount necessary to eliminate the
9 breach; and

10 (B) the amount made available from such
11 Accounts;

12 (2) if the sequestration under paragraph (1)
13 does not eliminate the breach, there shall be a se-
14 questration in accordance with such Act to eliminate
15 the remainder of the breach.
