1 At the appropriate place in title V, insert the fol-
2 lowing:

3 **SEC. 5 ____ . APPLICATION OF HIPAA REGULATIONS TO**
4 **CERTAIN SOFTWARE APPLICATIONS RECEIV-**
5 **ING PATIENT INFORMATION.**

6 Part C of title XI of the Social Security Act (42
7 U.S.C. 1320d et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
8 the following:

9 **“SEC. 1180A. APPLICATION OF HIPAA REGULATIONS CER-**
10 **TAIN SOFTWARE APPLICATIONS RECEIVING**
11 **PATIENT INFORMATION.**

12 “(a) SCOPE.—This section applies to an entity that
13 owns or maintains a software application or program that

1 is, or that uses, an application programming interface to
2 create, receive, maintain, or transmit individually identifi-
3 able health information, as that term is defined in section
4 160.103 of title 45, Code of Federal Regulations.

5 “(b) ISSUANCE OF REGULATIONS.—The Secretary
6 shall issue regulations prescribing the extent to which, and
7 the manner in which, the following rules (and any succes-
8 sors of such rules) shall apply to the activities of an entity
9 described in subsection (a) with respect to such entity’s
10 creation, receipt, maintenance, or transmittal of individ-
11 ually identifiable health information:

12 “(1) The Privacy Rule, part 160 and subparts
13 A and E of part 164 of title 45, Code of Federal
14 Regulations.”(2) The Security Rule, part 160 and
15 subparts A and C of part 164 of such title 45.

16 “(2) The Breach Notification Rule, part 160
17 and subparts A and D of part 164 of such title 45.

18 “(c) SUPPLEMENTAL PROVISIONS.—The Secretary
19 may include in the regulations under subsection (b) such
20 supplemental provisions on the subjects of the rules listed
21 in subsection (b) as the Secretary considers necessary to
22 address circumstances where, because of differences be-
23 tween the activities described by this section and the ac-
24 tivities covered by such rules, application of such rules to
25 the activities described by this section would not ade-

1 quately ensure privacy, security, or notification of
2 breaches.

3 “(d) ENFORCEMENT.—Section 1176 of the Social Se-
4 curity Act shall apply to violations of regulations issued
5 under this section, and the Secretary may include in such
6 regulations provisions implementing such section 1176
7 with respect to this section.

8 “(e) PROCEDURE.—

9 “(1) TIMING.—The Secretary shall issue the
10 initial set of regulations under this section not later
11 than 2 years after the date of enactment of the
12 Lower Health Care Costs Act.

13 “(2) AUTHORITY TO USE INTERIM FINAL PRO-
14 CEDURES.—The Secretary may make such initial set
15 of regulations effective and final immediately upon
16 issuance, on an interim basis, without making the
17 finding described by section 553(b)(B) of title 5,
18 United States Code, and provide for a period of pub-
19 lic comment on such initial set of regulations after
20 the date of publication.”.
