AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. Isakson with Mr. Burr

Viz:

1 At the end of title II, add the following:

2 **SEC. 2 . IMPORTATION OF CERTAIN SUNSCREEN PROD-**
3 **UCTS.**

4 Section 804 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic
5 Act (21 U.S.C. 384) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (b), by adding at the end the
7 following: “Such regulations shall not apply with re-
8 spect to certain sunscreen products, which are sub-
9 ject to subsection (m).”;

10 (2) by redesignating subsection (m) as sub-
11 section (n); and

1 (3) by inserting after subsection (1) the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(m) IMPORTATION OF SUNSCREEN PRODUCTS.—

4 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall allow
5 pharmacists and wholesalers to import nonprescrip-
6 tion sunscreen (as defined in section 586) products
7 from any of the countries listed in paragraph (2)—

8 “(A) if such sunscreen has been on the
9 market in such country for more than 5 years;
10 and

11 “(B) contains sunscreen active ingredients
12 (as defined in section 586(9)) not available in
13 the United States as of June 1, 2019.

14 “(2) COUNTRIES.—

15 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The countries de-
16 scribed in this paragraph are—

17 “(i) Australia, Canada, Israel, Japan,
18 Australia, and New Zealand, Switzerland,
19 and South Africa; and

20 “(ii) the European Union or a country
21 in the European Economic Area (the coun-
22 tries in the European Union and the Euro-
23 pean Free Trade Association) if the sun-
24 screen product is authorized for general

1 marketing in the European Economic
2 Area.

3 “(B) ADDITIONAL COUNTRIES.—The Sec-
4 retary may designate an additional country to
5 be included in the list of countries described in
6 this paragraph if the requirements described in
7 section 802(b)(1)(B) are met in the country
8 with respect to sunscreen.”.
