

## **S. 5103 Food and Drug Administration Foods Accountability Act**

### **Section 1. Short Title.**

This Act may be cited as the “Food and Drug Administration Foods Accountability Act”.

### **Section 2. FDA Human Foods Program Strategic Plan.**

This section requires that the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) submit a strategic plan for the Human Foods Program of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) every 3 years. The strategic plan should include priorities related to the implementation of food safety inspections, procedures related to critical food supply disruptions, nutrition programs, and other priorities within the Human Foods Program. The strategic plan shall also contain hiring priorities, specific strategies and activities to meet the goals of the program, plans to coordinate within the FDA and with outside agencies and stakeholders, challenges to the implementation of the strategic plan and specific evaluation metrics. The Secretary of HHS shall regularly evaluate progress of implementation of the strategic plan. Lastly, the Government Accountability Office (GAO) is required to submit a report to Congress on the creation and implementation of the strategic plan and make recommendations regarding the Human Foods Program.
