A BILL

To provide for the implementation of a Precision Medicine Initiative.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Advancing Precision
- 5 Medicine Act of 2016".
- 6 SEC. 2. PRECISION MEDICINE INITIATIVE.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
- 8 Human Services (referred to in this section as the "Sec-
- 9 retary") is encouraged to establish and carry out an initia-
- 10 tive, to be known as the "Precision Medicine Initiative",

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1	to augment efforts to address disease prevention, diag-	
2	nosis, and treatment.	
3	(b) Components.—The Initiative described under	
4	4 subsection (a) may include—	
5	(1) developing a network of scientists to assist	
6	in carrying out the purposes of the Initiative;	
7	(2) developing new approaches for addressing	
8	scientific, medical, public health, and regulatory	
9	science issues;	
10	(3) applying genomic technologies to provide	
11	data on the molecular basis of disease;	
12	(4) collecting information voluntarily provided	
13	by a diverse cohort of individuals that can be used	
14	to better understand health and disease; and	
15	(5) other activities determined appropriate by	
16	the Secretary to advance the goals of the Initiative.	
17	(c) Authority of the Secretary.—In carrying	
18	out this section, the Secretary may—	
19	(1) coordinate with the Secretary of Energy,	
20	private industry, and others determined appropriate	
21	by the Secretary to identify and address the ad-	
22	vanced supercomputing needs for the Initiative de-	
23	scribed under subsection (a);	
24	(2) develop and utilize public-private partner-	
25	ships; and

2	(d) REQUIREMENTS.—In the implementation of the
3	Initiative under subsection (a), the Secretary shall—
4	(1) ensure the collaboration of the National In
5	stitutes of Health, the Food and Drug Administra
6	tion, and the Office of the National Coordinator for
7	Health Information Technology;
8	(2) comply with existing laws and regulations
9	for the protection of human subjects involved in re
10	search, including the protection of participant pri
11	vacy;
12	(3) implement policies and mechanisms for ap
13	propriate secure data sharing across systems that
14	include protections for privacy and security of data
15	and
16	(4) consider the diversity of the cohort to en
17	sure inclusion of a broad range of participants, in
18	cluding consideration of biological, social, and other
19	determinants of health that contribute to health dis
20	parities.
