Viz:

1 Strike section 209 and insert the following:

2 **SEC. 209. PROGRAM TO SUPPORT COORDINATION AND**  
3 **CONTINUATION OF CARE FOR TRAUMA RE-**  
4 **COVERY PATIENTS.**

5 Section 7081 of the SUPPORT for Patients and  
6 Communities Act (42 U.S.C. 290dd-4) is amended—

7 (1) in the section heading, by striking “**DRUG**  
8 **OVERDOSE**” and inserting “**TRAUMA RECOV-**  
9 **ERY**”;

10 (2) in subsection (a)—

1 (A) in the matter preceding paragraph (1),  
2 by inserting “trauma-informed” after “develop-  
3 ment of”;

4 (B) in paragraph (1), by inserting “, sui-  
5 cide attempt, or violent injury” before the semi-  
6 colon;

7 (C) in paragraph (2)—

8 (i) by inserting “multidisciplinary  
9 teams, involving, as applicable, case man-  
10 agers, counselors, social workers, or” after  
11 “the use of”; and

12 (ii) by striking “experience a non-fatal  
13 overdose to seek treatment for substance  
14 use disorder and” and inserting “experi-  
15 ence an event described in paragraph (1)  
16 to seek treatment for substance use dis-  
17 order, behavioral health concerns, or par-  
18 ticipate in trauma-informed support serv-  
19 ices”;

20 (D) in paragraph (3), by striking “a drug  
21 overdose” and inserting “presenting to a hos-  
22 pital after experiencing an event described in  
23 paragraph (1)”;

24 (E) in paragraph (4), by striking “over-  
25 dose reversal medication, as appropriate” and

1 inserting “appropriately indicated medications,  
2 which may include overdose reversal medica-  
3 tion”;

4 (3) in subsection (b)—

5 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “a drug  
6 overdose” and inserting “presenting to a hos-  
7 pital after a drug overdose, suicide attempt, or  
8 violent injury”;

9 (B) by amending paragraph (2) to read as  
10 follows:

11 “(2) ELIGIBLE ENTITY.—In this section, the  
12 term ‘eligible entity’ means—

13 “(A) a State or local health agency, which  
14 may include a mental health services, public  
15 health, or substance abuse services agency;

16 “(B) an Indian Tribe or tribal organiza-  
17 tion;

18 “(C) a hospital or health system;

19 “(D) a certified community behavioral  
20 health clinic or federally qualified health clinic;  
21 or

22 “(E) a consortium of any entities described  
23 in subparagraph (A), (B), (C), or (D).”;

24 (C) in paragraph (3)(B)—

1 (i) by inserting “community-based or-  
2 ganization or” before “recovery commu-  
3 nity”; and

4 (ii) by striking “recovery coaches”  
5 and inserting “case managers, counselors,  
6 social workers, or recovery coaches, as ap-  
7 propriate”;

8 (D) in paragraph (4)—

9 (i) in subparagraph (A)—

10 (I) in the matter preceding clause  
11 (i), by striking “recovery coaches to  
12 help” and inserting “case managers,  
13 counselors, social workers, or recovery  
14 coaches, as appropriate, to help pre-  
15 vent readmission or injury, and to”;

16 (II) in clause (iii)—

17 (aa) by striking “after an  
18 overdose”; and

19 (bb) by inserting “trauma-  
20 informed” before “support serv-  
21 ices”;

22 (III) in clause (iv), by inserting  
23 “trauma-informed supports and” after  
24 “receiving”; and

1 (IV) in clause (v), by striking  
2 “recovery” and inserting “trauma-in-  
3 formed”; and

4 (ii) in subparagraph (C), by inserting  
5 “, suicide attempt, or violent injury,” after  
6 “drug overdose”;

7 (E) in paragraph (5)—

8 (i) in subparagraph (B), by striking “;  
9 or” and inserting a semicolon;

10 (ii) in subparagraph (C), by striking  
11 the period and inserting “; or”; and

12 (iii) by adding at the end the fol-  
13 lowing:

14 “(D) trauma-informed interventions, which  
15 may include comprehensive education, screen-  
16 ing, counseling, discharge planning, skills build-  
17 ing, and long-term care management services to  
18 such individuals, and their guardians or care-  
19 givers as appropriate, to prevent hospital read-  
20 mission, injury, and improve health, wellness,  
21 and safety outcomes.”; and

22 (F) in paragraph (6)—

23 (i) by striking subparagraph (A);



1 (ii) by redesignating subparagraphs  
2 (B) and (C) as subparagraphs (A) and  
3 (B), respectively;

4 (iii) in subparagraph (A), as so redesi-  
5 gnated, by striking “deaths that is above  
6 the national overdose mortality rate” each  
7 place it appears and inserting “death, sui-  
8 cide, or violence-related injury death that  
9 is above the applicable national rate”; and

10 (iv) in subparagraph (B), as so redesi-  
11 gnated, by striking “recovery coaches”  
12 and inserting “multidisciplinary teams, in-  
13 volving case managers, counselors, social  
14 workers, or recovery coaches, as applica-  
15 ble.”;

16 (4) in subsection (d)—

17 (A) in paragraph (1)—

18 (i) in subparagraph (A), by inserting  
19 “suicide attempt, or violent injury,” before  
20 “including”;

21 (ii) in subparagraph (C), by inserting  
22 “suicide attempt, or violent injury,” before  
23 “the types”; and

24 (iii) in subparagraph (D), by striking  
25 “and evidence of relapse related to sub-

1                   stance use disorder” and inserting “, sui-  
2                   cide attempts, and violent injuries”; and  
3                   (B) in paragraph (2)—  
4                   (i) by inserting “, suicide attempt, or  
5                   violent injury” after “drug overdose”;  
6                   (ii) by striking “experienced relapse”;  
7                   and  
8                   (iii) by inserting “, suicide attempt, or  
9                   violent injury” before the period at the  
10                  end; and  
11                  (5) by striking subsection (f).
