3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Pathways to Paychecks5 Act".

6 SEC. 2. EMPLOYMENT SERVICE OFFICES.

7 Section 9 of the Wagner-Peyser Act (29 U.S.C. 49h)

8 is amended by adding at the end the following:

9 "(d) States may use State merit staff or other staff
10 allowable under part 200 of title 2, Code of Federal Regu-

- 1 lations (or a successor regulation), to carry out the duties
- 2 of employment service offices under this Act.".
